

## HEALTH CARE AIDE

The program will prepare a health care worker who, under the supervision of a nurse, assists hospital patients, personal care home residents, or home care clients with meeting physical, emotional and social needs. Through theory classes, skills lab, home visits and clinical experience, the program will provide students with the knowledge and skills needed to meet the needs of clients and to assist them with activities of daily living.

### ENTRANCE REQUIREMENTS

The ETP reserves the right to limit the number of students admitted to the program. Courses offered are taught in French, however, fluency in the English language will be a deciding factor in the selection of candidates.

- Manitoba high school diploma (or equivalent) or mature student status (21 years of age and over)
- fluency in written and spoken English is necessary for clinical practice
- good health
- current immunization status prior to clinical practice
- evidence of current certification in CPR at Level B
- completion of Non-violent crisis intervention certificate prior to clinical placement
- proof of verification of Criminal Record Search and Child Abuse Registry Check

The following documents are to be submitted to the ETP for registration to the program :

- CPR Certificate Level B
- Criminal Record Check (six weeks prior to start date of program)
- Child Abuse Registry Check (six weeks prior to start date of program)
- Current immunization Record
